Join over 400 New Yorkers who volunteer with iMentor to make a difference in the lives of young people in New York City!

What is iMentor?

iMentor provides a flexible and meaningful way to work with high school students from underserved communities in New York City. iMentor matches adult volunteers one-on-one with students based on shared career or personal interests. Mentors and mentees correspond weekly via email. Pairs also meet in person at iMentor-hosted events and collaborate online on projects designed to improve mentees' reading, writing, research and technology skills.

What is required of volunteers?

Volunteers must be at least 21 years old, and must live OR work in the New York City metropolitan area. iMentor requires a minimum of a one year commitment to our program. Two, three and four year matches are also available. Mentors' time commitment averages 4-6 hours a month including: weekly email exchanges and monthly face-to-face meetings at iMentor-sponsored.

What do our volunteers say?

Eric Z., says about volunteering with iMentor: "As I see my life becoming more complicated with work, family and just plain getting older, my relationship with my mentee, Mugeeb, helps me to better put things into perspective because Mugeeb is in high school and at a completely different stage of his life than I am with mine. Sharing our life experiences with each other reminds me of the challenges that I faced and overcame when I was younger. I also really appreciate Mugeeb's fresh and original opinions and observations, which I would never have exposure to without this mentoring program."
